

Teacher develops and communicates to student lesson objectives and/or learning goals that are related to content/academic standards and aligned with the lesson's assessment.



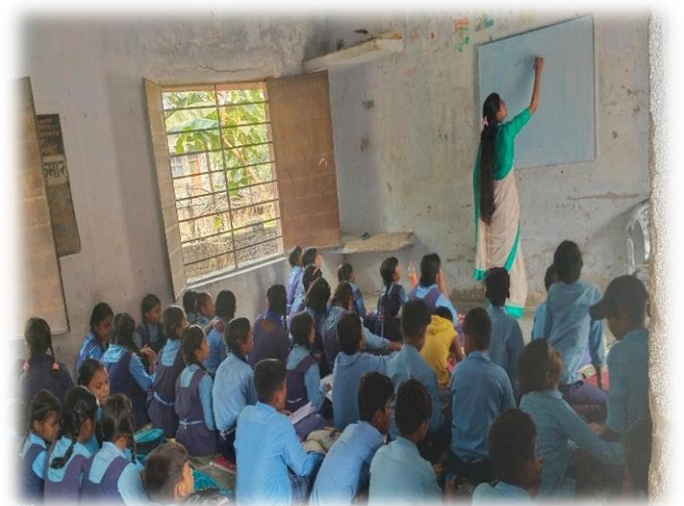
Pupil Teacher demonstrates thorough content and pedagogical content knowledge by providing students with accurate and clear explanations and clarification of misconceptions

Parents were encouraged to appreciate student's participation in all academic activities. This helped to create the necessary consciousness among parents to stimulate their interest in the students and the school.


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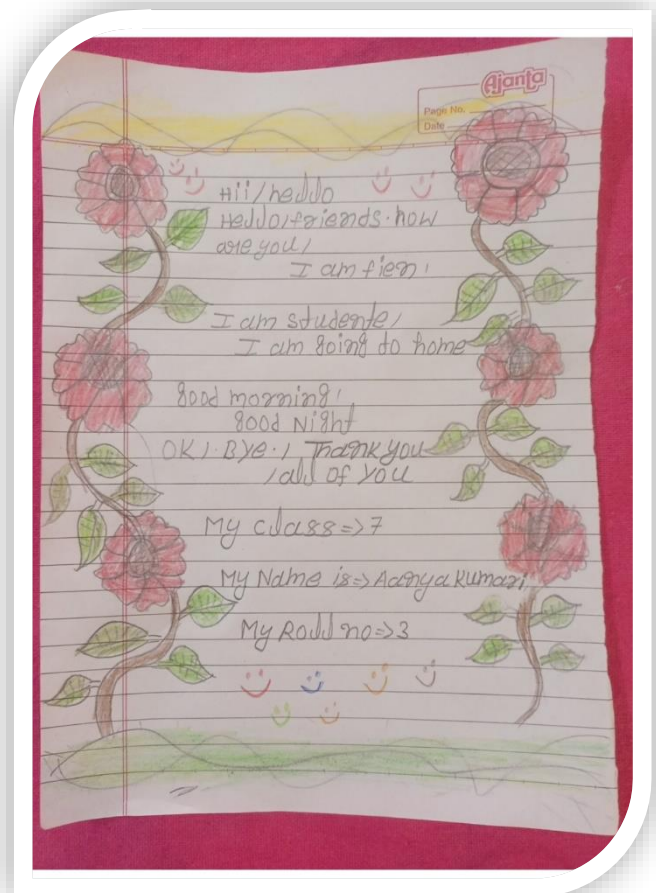
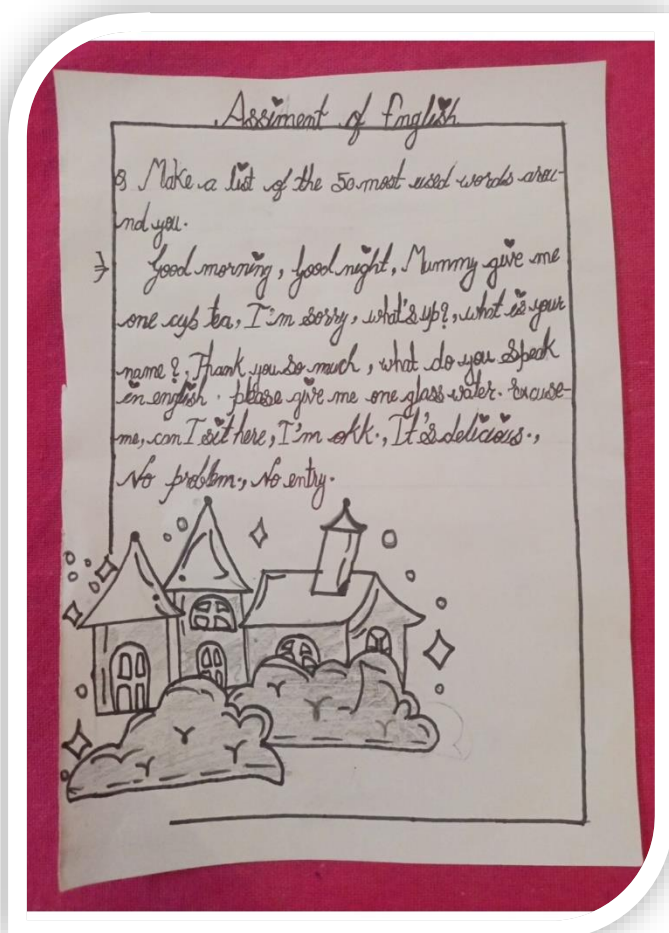
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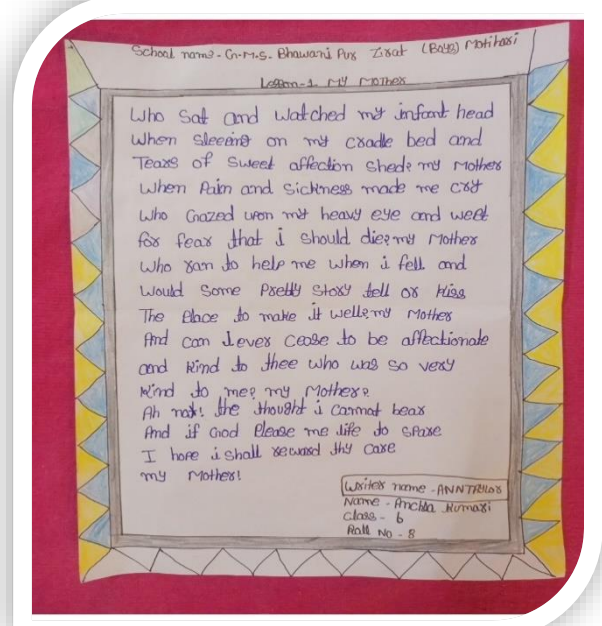
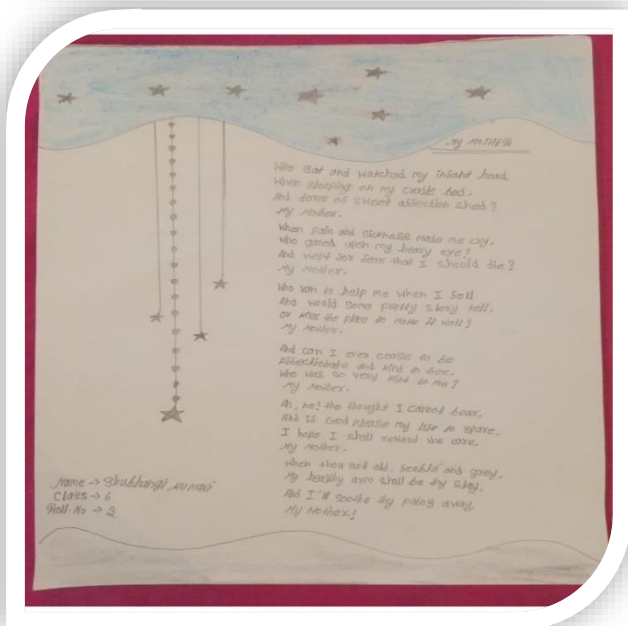
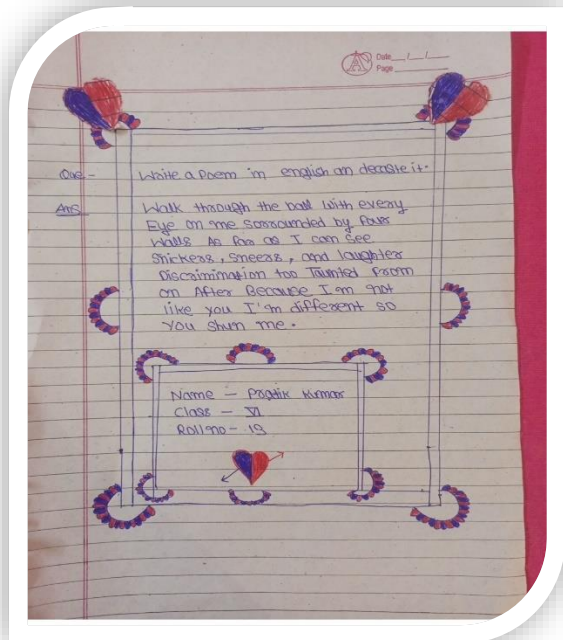
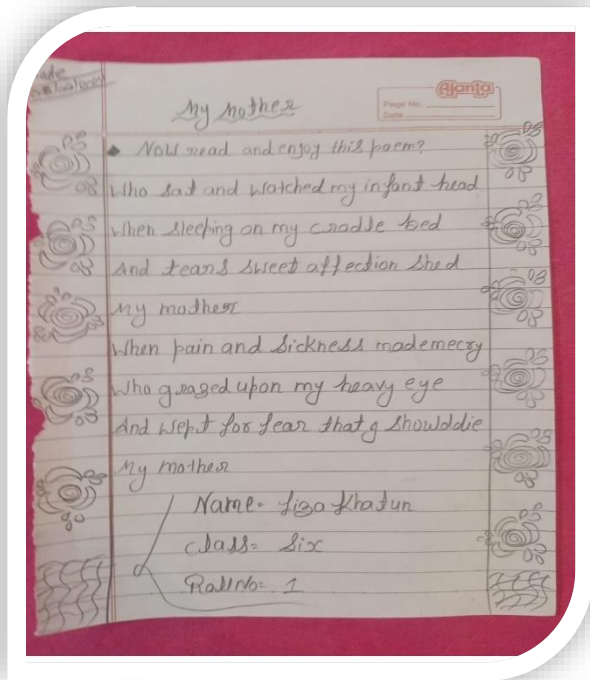
Report on Assessment of students learning Home Assignments
